

Isabelle Gautier and Dominique Petit appointed to the Board of Directors of Champagne Pol Roger

Isabelle Gautier, 43 years old, obtained a degree in finance and accounting at the University of Reims. She joined Pol Roger in 2007 after 13 years of experience within a charted accounting firm.

Passionately fond of music, this amateur pianist was promoted to Financial Director in July 2013.

Son, grandson and great-grandson of a Champagne winegrower, Dominique Petit, 60 years old, obtained his oenology diploma from the Science department of the University of Reims.

After more than 20 years spent with a prestigious Champagne House, he was recruited as Pol Roger's cellar master in 1999. This outstanding technician has deeply renovated and transformed the production tool of the family-owned company.
